This office received allegations from [REDACTED], [REDACTED] that an [REDACTED] employee, [REDACTED] had an improper relationship with a contractor, [REDACTED] of [REDACTED], who was bidding on a [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] claimed that [REDACTED], the [REDACTED] for the [REDACTED] had passed inside information to [REDACTED] giving [REDACTED] an unfair advantage in the procurement competition. [REDACTED] also filed a bid protest with GAO when the contract was awarded to [REDACTED].

On [REDACTED], the Comptroller General issued its decision denying the protest in part and dismissing it in part. The ruling stated that there were no evidence to support [REDACTED]'s claims. Based on this ruling, the allegations are unfounded. This case is closed without investigation or action.
