In response to our request of 4/17/90 for the basis of such a withdrawal, we received [REDACTED] letter dated 4/23/90. This letter complains of failure to be credited with the discovery of a letter important to the history of the development of the [REDACTED]. This letter neither claims or attempts to show any relationship with either a proposal to or award from the National Science Foundation.

On 4/30/90, I learned that a copy of my 4/17/90 letter to [REDACTED] had been sent anonymously along with certain other letters from various persons to the Chair, [REDACTED] Department, [REDACTED]

Since [REDACTED] matters do not reach us in a proposal or award, I am terminating our interest in this case.
