This case came to OIG in a 9/30/91 letter addressed to the Director, NSF, by [REDACTED] (the complainant), Project Director, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]
She strongly suggested intellectual theft of ideas she and her colleagues at the [REDACTED] Project had originated and developed. She indicated that charges of plagiarism could follow in connection with the workshop announced for the (subject's) [REDACTED] workshop, [REDACTED] scheduled for [REDACTED] 1992.

In response to OIG's request for specific allegations the complainant indicated that she had interacted with the subject and that she did not wish to pursue this matter. Since OIG's review through 31 March 93 could find nothing to link the subject's workshop with either a proposal to or an award from NSF, we are closing this case for lack of jurisdiction.
