

Closeout of M92030011

This case was referred to OIG by [REDACTED] [REDACTED] March 9, 1992. The NSF Director received a letter from the complainant, [REDACTED] who stated he recently completed work for his Ph.D. degree in [REDACTED] at the [REDACTED]. During his time at the University he was affiliated with the [REDACTED] as a graduate research assistant and through his advisor's involvement with the [REDACTED]. The [REDACTED] is an NSF funded [REDACTED] Research Center. The complainant expressed concerns about the management of the [REDACTED] and the ethical standards of some of the [REDACTED] faculty members. After consultation with OIG staff, the Inspector General concluded that these allegations did not rise to the level of misconduct in 45 C.F.R. 689. [REDACTED] the allegations were directed back to NSF management, and this case was closed.
