Dear Ms. Young:

Pursuant to the *Government Charge Card Abuse Prevention Act of 2012* (Pub. L. No. 112-194), Inspectors General must report to the Director of the Office of Management and Budget the agency's progress in implementing Government charge card audit recommendations.

We issued a purchase card audit report in May 2022.¹ As of September 30, 2023, the National Science Foundation (NSF) had no open purchase card audit recommendations. We are not submitting a semiannual Joint Purchase Card Violation Report because NSF's FY 2023 purchase card activity was less than \$10 million.

We issued our last travel card audit report in August 2015.² As of September 30, 2023, there were no outstanding NSF travel card audit recommendations. Travel card activity for FY 2023 was also less than \$10 million.
